

2010 SUPER HOINKE RULES

1. **PLAYING RULES-** Rules stated herein and those of the USBC will govern all participants of the tournament. The Tournament Manager and Committee will have the right to accept or reject any entry and decide all questions or disputes arising in the tournament. All decisions by the tournament committee will be considered final.
2. **ELIGIBILITY-** This tournament is open to all amateur bowlers and any P.B.A. member who is not exempt on the 2009-10 or 2010-2011 P.B.A. tour. Any bowler who has won a P.B.A National title since Jan 1st, 2006 is not eligible to participate in the 2010 Super Hoinke. Entrants who have not obtained the age of 18 by November 2^{4th}, 2010 must submit a parental consent form with entry. Entry applications will be accepted up until 1:30 P.M. Saturday November 27th, 2010. Entries close 15 minutes prior to each shift of Round #1 of competition. Any person who has been employed by S & S Western Bowl or Hoinke Classic during the period from January 1st, 2010 thru November 24th, 2010 is not eligible to participate.
3. **TOURNAMENT FORMAT-** The Super Hoinke will be conducted as a qualifying round to determine the top 32 bowlers. Bowlers who are eliminated in any of the first round on Friday will have the opportunity to re-enter the first round on Saturday. All entrants will choose a first round squad time and will draw for lane assignments one hour prior to that first round squad time. A maximum of two bowlers will be assigned to a lane (four bowlers to a pair).
FRIDAY: Round #1: (2 squads) 4 game qualifying round. The top half of each squad will advance to Round 2 on Saturday. Non-winners will be able to re-enter any available Round 1 shift times.
SATURDAY: Round #1: (2 squads) 4 game qualifying round. The top half of each squad will advance to Round 2 on Saturday. Non-winners of the first shift will be able to re-enter the second shift on Saturday.
Round #2: 4 game qualifying round to determine the top 32 bowlers. Non-winners will be eliminated from competition. Winners will advance to Round #3 on Sunday.
SUNDAY: Round #3: Bowlers bowl a 2 game match - total pinfall will determine winner. Winners will advance to Round #4. Non-winners will cash for not less than \$400.00 (actual amount to be determined by total entry count)
Round #4: Bowlers bowl a 2 game match - total pinfall will determine winner. Winners will advance to Round #5.
Round #5: Bowlers bowl a 2 game match - total pinfall will determine winner. Winners will advance to Round #6.
Round #6: Bowlers will bowl a Best 2 out of 3 match to determine winner. Winner will advance to Round #7.
Round #7: Bowlers will bowl a Best 2 out of 3 match to determine winner of the 2010 Super Hoinke.
4. **BYES-** The placement of all byes will be determined by the tournament committee at the appropriate time dependent on the total entry count.
5. **SUBSTITUTIONS-** Substitutions will not be permitted at any time during any scheduled match for any reason. Failure to complete any scheduled match will result in the elimination of that bowler. Prize money will be awarded for the last cash category of the level of the competitive round in which the bowler fails to continue.
6. **LATE BOWLERS-** A bowler arriving late may join his/her assigned squad in progress. He/she will receive "0" score for each frame missed.
7. **LANE DRAWING-** Bowlers must be present for drawing of lane assignment and position as scheduled for every round of competition in which they are eligible to compete. Failure to comply will result in forfeiture of entry fee, game, and the elimination of that contestant.
8. **EQUIPMENT-** Entrants may use any amount of bowling balls in each match. Plugged balls will be permitted in competition.
9. **PRIZE MONEY-** The prize money of any disqualified bowler whose disqualification resulted in the elimination of previous round opponents, shall be distributed equally among those opponents. All entrants agree that there shall be no liability on the part of the Super Hoinke, S & S Western Bowl, and/or its officers and employees in complying with such a ruling.
10. **AUTOMATIC SCORING-** Automatic scoring will be used. Bowlers will certify their scores as being correct at the completion of each game by initialing the official score sheet. Should a scorer malfunction and the scores can not be retrieved, the match will be re-bowled.
11. **SPONSORED BOWLERS-** All interested bowlers may obtain a "Sponsor", Backer or investor to participate in the payment of the entry fee. However, all prizes earned in the Super Classic will be submitted directly to the contestant.
12. **TIES-** All ties shall be broken by a 9th and 10th frame roll-off. Luck of the draw will determine who starts the tie breaker.
13. **PRACTICE-** Each round, all bowlers will be permitted 10 minutes of practice bowling before each match.
14. **RE-RACKS-** Super Hoinke officials reserve the right to limit the number of re-racks a bowler may take at any time during a match.
15. **CANCELLATION-** If by War, Fire, Tornado, Gas Shortage, Water Damage, Labor Strike, etc or Act of GOD, it becomes impossible to conduct the Super Hoinke as publicized, all entry fees will be returned.
